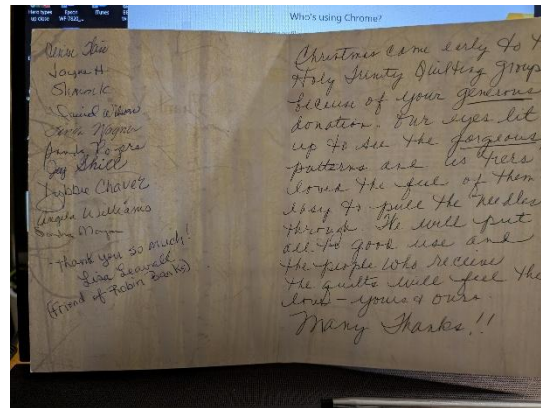
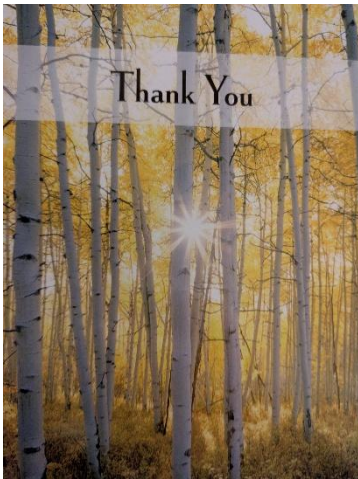




## Business Meeting
